Information

1. Weight categories and conditions for participants:

- a) Participants' age of European open championship for adults - 18 years of the day of the competition;
- b) Kumite men - Open weight category, Kumite women - Open weight category;
- c) There will be no limit of participants per country and organization.

2. Preliminary schedule:

- 2nd December 2021, Thursday:** arrival of EFKO, EKO Boards, committees, invited referees, participants.
- 3rd December 2021, Friday:** arrival of participants of National teams
09:00-18:00 COVID tests, weight and medical control;
09:00 Committees meetings;
11:00 – 17:00 Referee seminar, examination;
18:30 Draws.
- 4th December 2021, Saturday:** 10:00 - European Cup in weight categories and kata.
- 5th December 2021, Sunday:** **10:00 – European Karate Open Category Championship.**
- 6th December 2021, Monday:** checkout and departure.

3. Financial conditions:

- a) Accommodation, flight tickets, transportation and meals for all participants shall be covered by National Organization or Club or by participant;
- b) Participation fee 50 Euro per each participant;
- c) **Champions, 2nd and 3rd places winners will be awarded with the medals and the prize money: 1st place – 1500 €, 2nd place – 1000 €, two 3rd places – 600 €.**

4. Accommodation and Championship package, nearest international airports:

Important information: according to the established regulations, accommodation of arriving teams in the official hotel is a mandatory requirement.

4* “Radisson Hotel Kaunas” hotel – headquarter (official hotel for all delegations):

60 € night/person in TWIN (DBL) / **90 €** night/person in SINGLE room with - breakfast, lunch at the competition venue and dinner, transfers and entrance to the competition venue, COVID tests at arrival day.

Special accommodation and Championship package price is valid for stay **minimum 3 nights and includes:**

- 3 nights accommodation with breakfast;
- 3 buffet dinners (3rd-4th-5th December);
- 2 lunches at the competition Venue (4th-5th December);
- 2 days transfers Hotel-Kėdainių Arena-Hotel;
- Entrance to the competition venue.

Shorter stay in this hotel not possible during the event. Extra night accommodation on request.
All payments should be paid by bank transfer.

Riga (276 km.) 35 Eur per person/one way.

5. Participation requirements for fighters and coaches:

All competitors are requested to present:

- Written medical certificate (in English) indicating that he or she is physically fit and healthy, and his/her insurance documents. This medical certificate must be not older than 1 month (women are requested to present written certificate of non-pregnant state);
- Declaration for participation in the tournament.
- The coach must wear the official team uniform.
